My dear Mr. Arnold:

Some time ago, I was given to understand that the empty lot in the Circle Drive area, adjoining the station plaza, had been bought by the village of Plandome Manor as a parking space for its residents. Accordingly, my daughter parked her car there Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of last week.

Upon the complaint of someone living on Circle Drive, my daughter was thereupon threatened by the police with a ticket, which was only withdrawn at the intervention of Mr. Gilbert Johnstone.

I cannot believe it is the intention of the Village Board to deny residents living a distance from the station permission to use ground for which they have paid, nor that the tax-payers money was appropriated merely to give those within walking distance of the station a convenient foot-path.

As a tax-payer and part owner of the property, I would be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of your Board at your next meeting in order that rights of all residents may be determined and protected.
