## Fentanyl - A Dangerous Narcotic

The Nassau County Police Department (NCPD) would like to bring the public's attention to an alarming trend of brightly colored versions of the dangerous narcotic Fentanyl.

**FENTANYL IS A SYNTHETIC OPIOID THAT IS 50 TIMES MORE POTENT THAN HEROIN AND 100 TIMES MORE POTENT THAN MORPHINE!**

The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has noticed an increase in "rainbow fentanyl" pills and powder that come in a variety of bright colors, shapes, and sizes. Some versions of this drug are shaped to resemble sidewalk chalk. This is a deliberate effort by drug traffickers to drive addiction among children.

**JUST TWO MILLIGRAMS OF FENTANYL, IS EQUAL TO 10-15 GRAINS OF TABLE SALT, IS CONSIDERED A LETHAL DOSE!**
