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### Absentee Ballots

#### Who Can Apply:

You may apply for an absentee ballot if you will be:

- Absent from the county for all hours the polls are open (vacation, school, or business travel)
- Unable to appear at the polls due to illness or disability
- Permanently disabled
- Providing primary care for someone who is ill or physically disabled
- A military voter or in military service
- A student living away from home
- Incarcerated or detained in jail awaiting trial

#### Apply:

##### **Applying in person (applicant or agent):**

The Village Clerk may receive personal applications from the voter or the voter's agent through **Tuesday, March 17, 2026 (the day before the election)**.

Upon receiving a personal application, the absentee ballot will be delivered directly to the applicant or the agent named in the application.

**Or**

##### **To receive your ballot by mail:**

Your application must be received by the Village Clerk no later than **Tuesday, March 10, 2026**.

Applications must be received by this date to have a ballot mailed. Voters who miss the mailing deadline may apply in person through March 17, 2026 and will be issued a ballot directly.

##### **Signature Requirement:**

**Applications must be the original signed application (wet signature required).**

Copies, scans, or electronic signatures cannot be accepted.

##### **\*Return Your Ballot:**

Completed absentee ballots must be received by the Village Clerk by the close of polls on Election Day, **Wednesday, March 18, 2026**.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Who may apply for an absentee ballot?**

Each person must apply for themselves. It is a felony to make a false statement in an application for an absentee ballot, to attempt to cast an illegal ballot, or to help anyone to cast an illegal ballot.

**Where and when to return your application:**

**Applications must be mailed seven (7) days before the election, or hand-delivered to your Village Clerk by the day before the election.**

**Options available to you if you have an illness or disability:**

If you check the box indicating your illness or disability is permanent, once your application is approved you will automatically receive a ballot for each election in which you are eligible to vote, without having to apply again. You may sign the absentee ballot application yourself, or you may make your mark and have your mark witnessed in the spaces provided on the bottom of the application. Please note that a power of attorney or printed name stamp is not allowed for any voting purpose.

**When your ballot will be sent:**

Your absentee ballot materials will be sent to you at least 6 days before the election in which you are eligible to vote. If applicant or agent delivers the application to the Village Clerk in person after the seventh day before the village election and not later than the day before the election, the Village Clerk shall deliver such absentee ballots for those applicants who he determines are qualified to make such applications and to receive such ballots to such applicants or the agents named in the applications when such applicants or agents appear in the Village Clerk's office.

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### Early Mail Ballots

#### Who Can Apply:

Any qualified voter who prefers to vote early by mail instead of voting in person on Election Day may apply.

#### Apply:

##### **Applying in person (applicant or agent):**

The Village Clerk may receive personal applications from the voter or the voter's agent through **Tuesday, March 17, 2026 (the day before the election)**.

Upon receiving a personal application, the early mail ballot will be delivered directly to the applicant or the agent named in the application, provided the applicant is qualified to vote in the election.

**Or**

##### **To receive your ballot by mail:**

Your application must be received by the Village Clerk no later than Tuesday, March 10, 2026.

Applications must be received by this date to have a ballot mailed. Voters who miss the mailing deadline may apply in person through March 17, 2026, and will be issued a ballot directly.

#### **Signature Requirement**

**Applications must be the original signed application (wet signature required).**

Copies, scans, or electronic signatures cannot be accepted.

#### **\*Return Your Ballot:**

Completed early mail ballots must be received by the Village Clerk by the close of polls on Election Day, Wednesday, March 18, 2026.
